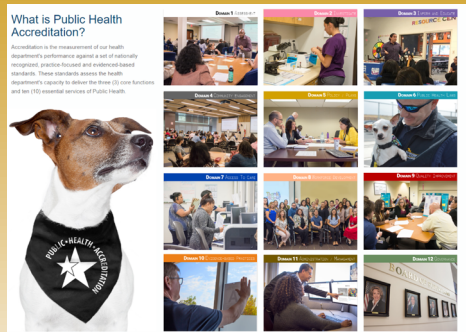


WHAT IS THE GOAL OF ACCREDITATION?

STEP 3

Accreditation Timeline

Current Progress: Step 3

On January 10, 2017, the Department submitted the online application and required fee to the Public Health Accreditation Board (PHAB). The Department's Accreditation Coordinator shared PHAB's Accreditation Timeline (March 30, 2017) and completed an update on May 15, 2017, which already began the Department's review. The Department has been granted access to the PHAB e-PHAB system and on June 1, 2017, successfully uploaded the first three documents. The Department is currently working on uploading the remaining documents and Department's community and PHAB Support and Resources. PHAB Support and Resources will be available on PHAB's website.

All goals to be completed by 10/1/18.

Over 200 Documents Uploaded

As of today we have uploaded over 200 documents to the Public Health Accreditation Board's (PHAB) e-PHAB system! We are almost two-thirds of the way to submitting all our required documents.

Below you will find a screenshot of the Department's e-PHAB page where you can visually see our progress. Pink boxes represent those measures that we have not uploaded any documentation for yet. White boxes represent those that are in progress, but have not yet completed. The yellow boxes represent those that the Accreditation Coordinator is reviewing. The light green boxes represent those that the Director is reviewing. The dark green boxes represent those that are ready for submission to PHAB. By the time we are all finished uploading all of our documents to the e-PHAB system, all of the boxes will turn dark green.

Be on the lookout for updates as we get closer to the day Trudy Raymundo, our Director, presses the final submit button and sends all of our documents to PHAB. Our final day to submit documents into the e-PHAB system is March 30th.
